

EVENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions apply between the person, firm, company or other entity specified on your registration form (“**you**” or “**your**”) and Causaly Limited, a company registered in England and Wales with registered office address at 10-16 Elm Street, London, England, WC1X 0BJ, with company number 11368328, and its affiliates (collectively “**Causaly**”). Please read these terms carefully as they contain important information relating to your registration for the event specified on your registration form (“**Event**”). By submitting your registration to attend the Event, you agree to be bound by these terms (the “**Terms**”). If you do not agree to be bound by these Terms, Causaly will be unable to accept your registration.

1. **Registration.** With respect to registration for the Event: (i) you agree to provide accurate, current and complete information about yourself during registration for the Event (“**Registration Data**”) and at any other points as may be required by Causaly; (ii) you agree to update your Registration Data as required to keep it up to date, current and complete; (iii) where you register for the Event as a representative of a company or other organisation, you warrant and represent that you have the authority to agree to these Terms on their behalf; and (iv) you acknowledge and agree that it is your responsibility to inform us of any special access requirements or dietary requirement at the time of registration, and in no event, later than five business days in advance of the Event. Failure to meet such requirements may result in such special access or dietary requests being unavailable on the day of the Event.
2. **Event passes.** Where the Event requires an Event pass to enable entry, you may be required to provide evidence of your identity for your Event pass to be issued to you. You agree to keep your pass on your person at all times during your attendance at the Event, and you acknowledge that Causaly reserves the right to refuse entry or eject you if you fail to produce a pass when requested. Where an Event pass is lost, misplaced, stolen or forgotten, a replacement pass will be issued to you at the sole discretion of Causaly, which may be subject to purchase. You must not sell, transfer or share your Event pass. All Event passes are property of Causaly and must be returned to Causaly upon request and/or at the end of the Event.
3. **Attendance requirements.** In attending the Event, you shall: (i) observe any rules, policies and procedures of the Event venue, including in relation to health and safety and any other reasonable instructions issued by the host of the venue and/or Causaly; and (ii) behave in a respectful, professional and appropriate manner. Causaly reserves the right to, at its sole discretion and without refund or compensation, to refuse admittance or to expel you from the Event.
4. **Speakers, sponsors and exhibitors.** Any and all views expressed by any attendee, speaker, exhibitor or sponsor at the Event are their own and in no way represent the views or opinions of Causaly. Under no circumstances shall Causaly have any liability for advice given, or views expressed, by any attendee, speaker, exhibitor or sponsor at the Event, or in any materials provided to you.
5. **Event amendments and disclaimer.** Causaly reserves the right to make changes to the agenda, format, speakers and location and any other aspect of the Event with or without notice and without liability to you.
6. **Intellectual property rights.** All intellectual property rights in and to the Events and any materials, data, information and/or products provided by Causaly as part of the Event remain the intellectual property of Causaly or its third party licensors (the “**Content**”). You may use such Content for your own personal use and not for resale or other commercial purpose or distribution, including on the internet or via social media. Any request for permission to republish, reprint or use for any other purpose any of the Content should be sent by e-mail to marketing@causaly.com.

7. Personal information. By registering for the Event, you agree to allow Causaly to process your personal information in accordance with Causaly's privacy policy, available at: <https://www.causaly.com/privacy-policy>. All personal information will be held and processed in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.
8. Use of image and likeness. By registering and attending the Event, you (i) irrevocably grant non-exclusive permission to Causaly, and its affiliates, successors, assigns and designees, to capture and use your name, voice, portrait, video, and likeness ("**Likeness**") in photographs, audio recordings, and video recordings taken during the Event for any legitimate purpose, including but not limited to promoting, advertising and marketing activities, and to use the Likeness in any form of media, throughout the world and in perpetuity; (ii) understand that Causaly shall own all right, title and interest to any materials or works resulting from the use of the Likeness ("**Works**") and that it may exploit, edit, modify, and distribute the Works without limitation or compensation, or further permission or notification to you; (iii) waive the right to inspect or approve versions of any Works used for publication or the written copy that may be used in connection with the Works; (iv) waive any claims that may arise with regard to the use of the Likeness, including any claims of defamation, invasion of privacy, or infringement of moral rights, rights of publicity, or copyright.
9. Assumption of COVID-19 and other risks. You acknowledge and accept that coronavirus and any resulting disease is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death and that there is an inherent danger and risk of exposure to coronavirus in any place where people are present and that no safety protocols can completely eliminate the risk of exposure to coronavirus. By accepting these Terms, you agree that your attendance to the Event and entry into the venue where the Event is being hosted is entirely at your own risk and Causaly will in no way be held responsible for any illness, injury or harm, including but not limited to contracting coronavirus or any other contagious disease. You further understand that it is your responsibility to adhere to all safety guidelines, protocols and requirements set forth by local health authorities, the venue and Causaly, and any failure to do so may result in your removal from the Event without any refund or compensation.
10. Force Majeure. Causaly shall not be held responsible or liable for any delay or failure in performance of its obligations hereunder (including the holding or hosting of the Event), to the extent that such delay or failure is caused by: (i) storm, flood, fire, earthquake or other acts of God; (ii) war, invasion, hostilities, terrorist threats or acts, riot, or other civil unrest or violence; (iii) any disease, epidemic or pandemic; (iv) embargoes or blockades; (v) national or regional emergency; (vi) strikes, labour stoppages, slowdowns or other industrial disturbances; (vii) any order or guidance from any governmental or quasi-governmental organisation, including without limitation, in regard to travel, public gatherings or health and safety; (viii) disruptions in supply chains, hotel inventory, commercial air travel or other public transportation; (ix) failure of carriers or utilities or equipment beyond Causaly's reasonable control; (x) unavailability of the venue through no fault of Causaly; or (xi) other similar causes beyond the reasonable control of Causaly. In any such event, Causaly shall be entitled to, but not obligated, to either provide alternative facilities or venue for the Event and/or reschedule the Event, without liability on the part of Causaly. Where Causaly is unable to reschedule and/or rearrange the Event, Causaly may cancel the Event and in no event will Causaly be liable for any costs, expenses or damages incurred by you as a result of such cancellation or rescheduling, including, without limitation, travel expenses, accommodation costs or any other consequential or incidental damages.
11. Insurance. It is your sole responsibility to arrange appropriate insurance appropriate or necessary for your attendance to the Event and for coverage of your personal property, health or other

associated risks in connection with the Event. Except as state otherwise in these Terms, Causaly shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to personal property or health, or for any other unforeseen circumstances that may occur during the Event.

13. Liability which cannot be excluded. Nothing in these terms limits or excludes either party's liability (as applicable) for: (i) death or personal injury caused by its negligence, or the negligence of its employees, agents or subcontractors (as applicable); (ii) fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation or wilful default; (iii) and any matter in respect of which it would be unlawful to exclude or restrict liability.
14. Indirect or consequential losses. Subject to the requirements of applicable law and subject to Clause 13, Causaly will not be liable to you, whether in contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty, or otherwise, for any indirect or consequential losses, damages or expenses incurred by you as an attendee, including but not limited to personal injury, property damage, travel expenses, or any other similar losses or damages, arising out of or in connection with your attendance at the Event or any breach of these Terms by Causaly.
15. Total aggregate liability. The total aggregate liability of Causaly to you in respect of all other losses or damage arising under or in connection with these Terms, whether in contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty or otherwise shall be limited to the lower of: (i) the price paid by you for attendance to the Event; or (ii) ten dollars (\$10).
16. Invalidity. If any provision of these Terms becomes unenforceable, it shall be deemed deleted, but that shall not affect the enforceability of the rest of these Terms.
17. Third Party Rights. A person who is not a party to these Terms shall not have any rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce any provision of these Terms.
18. Governing Law. These Terms and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with them or their subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be exclusively governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the state of New York.
